

Third Party Authorization Form

Option to Assign Point of Contact and Rebate Payment to Third Party

A Customer may authorize a Third Party (defined as a Contractor or Property Management Company) to perform activities associated with securing rebate incentives on their behalf. Specifically:

- · Filing rebate applications
- Transmitting and receiving utility correspondence, authorizations and approvals as required for rebate incentive applications
- Obtaining past utility consumption history, utility energy studies, analysis and reporting
- Obtaining other utility account information applicable to evaluating incentive program participation.
- Receiving rebates
 - PLEASE NOTE: The NYSEG/RG&E rebate payment will be made to the Customer unless Customer and Third Party complete
 the section below to assign the payment to the Third Party. An IRS Form W-9 (Request for Taxpayer Identification Number
 and Certification) for the Third Party named below must be attached if this option is selected.
 - Post-Inspections will be performed on all projects that receive third party payments.

Accordingly, Third Party understands that it shall have no rights against NYSEG/RG&E or the Implementation Contractor with respect to such assignment or the payment of the rebate. In the event that NYSEG/RG&E does not pay the rebate as a result of Customer's failure to comply with the Application agreement, Third Party's sole recourse shall be against Customer. Customer directs NYSEG/RG&E to pay any rebate to which it is entitled to the Third Party named below and waives all rights to directly receive the NYSEG/RG&E rebates for the identified energy-efficiency project. Per program guidelines, all projects with third party payment will require 100% post-inspection prior to final approval.
